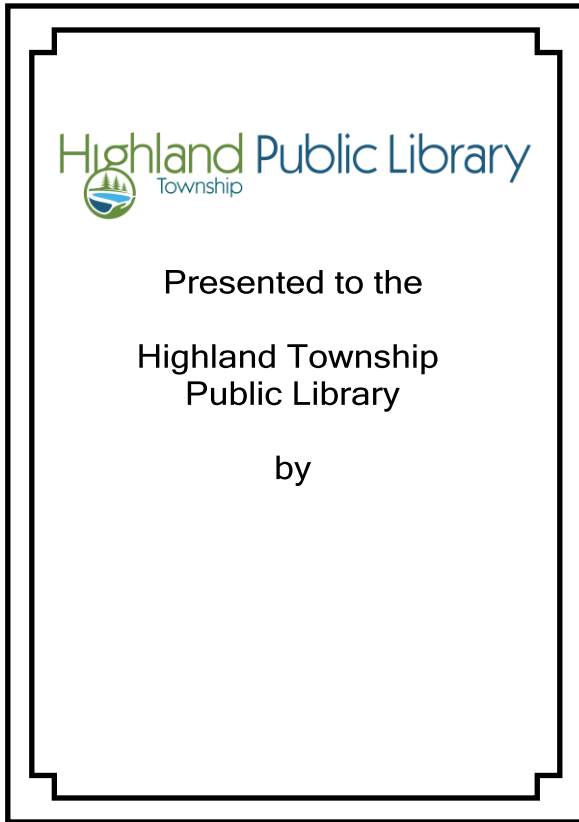

A gift to the Highland Township Library’s collection is one of the most satisfying ways of ensuring that your gift will live, be cared for, and continue to be used. It can reflect the taste of the giver or, in the case of memorials, the individual in whose memory it is given. A gift is an excellent way for an organization to help the community with books or materials in the field in which the organization has an interest.

For example, a history buff might increase the library’s holding in the field of history, biographies, maps and pictures.

If you do not wish to designate a specific subject, you can make your contribution in general for the purchase of books.

Book gifts may be given to the library for a variety of reasons. Books are often donated “in memoriam,” or to commemorate an occasion, birthday, anniversary, graduation, or other milestone.

An acknowledgement is given to the donor and the person, or family of the person being honored, and a bookplate is placed in the gift book.
